

EMERGENCY VEHICLE (PRACTICAL)

AE-DRIV-08

↳ PERSONS CONCERNED:

For a maximum of 4 persons.

Persons who hold a light vehicle and/or heavy truck driver's license and who are employed as drivers of rescue vehicles (firefighters, ambulance drivers, etc.).

↳ PREREQUISITES:

AE-DRIV-01-08 (Theory), valid driving licence verified on site.

↳ OBJECTIVES:

To anticipate potential road traffic accident situations. To respond to the urgency of the driving situations. To efficiently develop the aptitude to observe and the aptitude to control the vehicle. To demonstrate low-risk driving techniques.

COURSE CONTENTS

↳ Module 1 - Inspection before departure

- External inspection
- Conducting a general inspection
- Driving position
- Internal inspection
- Brakes
- Wheels and wheel rims.

↳ Module 2 - Driving during a mission

- Use of warning lights and sirens
- Driving under police escort.

↳ Module 3 - Commentary driving

Participants are assessed in the field during commentary driving training exercises to check and consolidate the modules covered previously in the theory sessions.

↳ Assessment

At the end of each session (theory and practical), the drivers' skills will be assessed.

Moving on to the practical session is dependent on the result of a multiple-choice questionnaire that tests theoretical knowledge.

Drivers must successfully complete both assessments to be considered proficient, and will then receive a certificate of proficiency.
